



Chapter
303
Student Government Transition

1
2 303.1 The President-elect and Vice President-elect shall begin a paid transition period on the first
3 Monday after Spring Break or the first Monday after the election results are certified,
4 whichever comes later.

5
6 303.1.1 During the transition period, the President-elect and Vice President-elect may utilize
7 some Student Government resources and are entitled to full payroll benefits.

9 303.2 The President-elect and Vice President-elect may begin the interview process for the
10 following members of their staff upon the certification of the election results:

12 303.2.1 Chief of Staff

13 303.2.2 Chief Financial Officer

14 303.2.3 Attorney General

15 303.2.4 Solicitor General

17 303.3 All appointment memos for individuals selected via the interview process shall not take
18 effect until the first day of the new term.

20 303.4 The Student Body President-elect, upon taking office, may make temporary appointments to
21 aid throughout the transition so long as the applicable budget allows it. These appointments
22 shall not extend beyond the end of the applicable fiscal year. The Senate President must be
23 notified of all temporary transition-limited appointments.

25 303.5 The President-elect may work to propose a new executive structure and budget during the
26 transition. The structure and budget shall be subject to the Senate's approval prior to taking
27 effect. The proposal shall not be considered by the Senate before the commencement of the
28 new applicable Student Government Term.
