



Chapter

216

Student Government Contracts and Agreements

1 **216.1** All contracts and agreements mandating a one-time expenditure shall require the
2 authorization of the Chief Financial Officer.

3
4 **216.1.1** The Chief Financial Officer shall be required to inform the Student Body President,
5 the Senate President, SGATO, ASBO, and the Chair of the Senate Committee on
6 Appropriations and Audits of any such expenditure forty-eight hours prior to the
7 action.

8 **216.1.1.1.** If the expenditure request requires action to be taken in less than forty-eight
9 hours, the Student Body President and Senate President shall be required to inform the
10 parties immediately upon taking action

11
12 **216.2** All contracts and agreements which mandate a reoccurring expense of less than \$50,000 a
13 year shall require the authorization of both the Student Body President and the Senate
14 President.

15
16 **216.2.1** The Student Body President and Senate President shall be required to inform
17 SGATO, ASBO, the Chief Financial Officer, and the Chair of the Senate Committee
18 on Appropriations and Audits of any such expenditure forty-eight hours prior to the
19 action.

20 **216.2.1.1.** If the expenditure request requires action to be taken in less than forty-eight
21 hours, the Student Body President and Senate President shall be required to inform the
22 parties immediately upon taking action

23 **216.3** All contracts and agreements which mandate a reoccurring expense of more than \$50,000 a
24 year shall require the authorization of The Senate by a majority vote.

26 **216.3.1** The Senate President shall be required to inform the Chief Financial Officer, the
27 Student Body President, SGATO, and ASBO of any such expenditure within forty-
28 eight hours of the action.

29
30 **216.3.2** The Senate may delegate its final approval responsibilities to the Senate President
31 and Student Body President within established parameters, as it deems appropriate.

32
33 **216.4** All non-monetary Agreements shall require the joint consent of the Senate President and
34 Student Body President. The Senate President shall notify the Senate of all such agreements
35 at the next regularly scheduled meeting.

36
37 **216.4.1** The Student Body President and the Senate President shall be required to
38 inform the Attorney General, SGATO and ASBO.
