borough County of the State of Maine
for a license for Hannigan, and it ap-

Judge that no legal impediment exists
to the marriage now sought to be
solemnized, there are therefore to certifi-
cate you to unite in the Holy Estate
of Matrimony, Herman Turner
and Clara Hightower, and make return
of the same to the County Judge afore-
said.
