

UNITED STATES OF AMERICA.

STATE OF FLORIDA, COUNTY OF HILLSBOROUGH.

Be it Remembered, That on the First day of March, A.D. 1902, Hugh C Macfarlane late of Scotland, at present of Hillsborough County, Florida, appeared in the Circuit Court of the Sixth Judicial Circuit of Florida, and applied to said Court to be admitted to become a citizen of the United States of America; and it appearing to the Court by the testimony of John T Lesley and M B Macfarlane of Hillsborough, County, Florida, that said applicant has resided in the United States during the last thirty six years, and for the year last past has resided within the State of Florida; and it further appearing that he came to the United States at the age of thirteen years, and has since resided continuously therein, and that he made a declaration of his intention to become a citizen of the United States according to the statutes, more for more than two years last past, it has been his bona fide intention to become a citizen of the United States since, and that he is over twenty-one years of age, and is in all other respects entitled to become a naturalized citizen: It is therefore ordered that the said Hugh C Macfarlane be allowed to take the oath of allegiance to the United States and become a citizen thereof.

Whereupon the said Hugh C Macfarlane takes the oath of allegiance required by law and is admitted and adjudged to be a naturalized citizen of the United States of America.
