USF St. Petersburg search committee narrows candidate pool for next chancellor to six, schedules interviews

The USF St. Petersburg Regional Chancellor Search Advisory Committee met on Monday, Jan. 14, and voted to narrow its pool of candidates to lead the institution to six.

The six candidates will be invited to interview in person over two days at the Marriott at Tampa International Airport, Jan. 28-29.
