being a Court of Record), and applied to the said Court to be admitted to become a citizen of
the United States of America, pursuant to the directions and acquisitions of the several acts
of Congress in relation thereto; and the said Charles Norman having
produced to the Court such declarations and renunciations, and taken such Oaths as are by
such acts required;

THEREUPON it is ordered that the said Charles Norman
be admitted, and he is accordingly admitted by said Court to be a citizen of the United States
of America.
