John Philip Perchar has resided within the United States during the last five years; and for the year last past  
 has resided within the State of Florida; and that he made a declaration of his intention to become a citizen of the United States according to  
 the Statute, more than two years since; and that he is over twenty-one years of age; and is in all other respects entitled to become a naturalized  
 citizen. It is therefore ORDERED that the said John Philip Perchar be allowed to take the oath of  
 allegiance to the United States, and become a citizen thereof. WHEREUPON the said John Philip Perchar  
 takes the oath of allegiance required by law, and is admitted and adjudged to be a naturalized CITIZEN of the United States of America.
