sees have been so foolish as to comply with any such demands, gives me continued assurance that they will
not pay any attention to them; and to make known the precise state of affairs, I submit the following facts:
I am the owner of Letters Patent No. 31,601, dated June 22, 1869, which covers a process and apparatus in
every way superior to the Robinson apparatus, and which, in the opinion of competent experts, is a complete
anticipation of the Robinson patent.
My patent of June 22, 1869, was not brought into the Sutter suit, about which so much is said in a circular
issued by the Robinson Tobacco Company. Aside from this 1869 patent, which covers the apparatus now in
use by me, I own other patents for processes, without which tobacco cannot be successfully resweated. I have
some fourteen patents in all, while the Robinson Company have but one, which covers only an apparatus, and
as no process is described or claimed, it is impossible to operate it successfully without using my patented
processes, which are not only described in my patents, but are also set forth in a hand-book published by me
for the benefit of my licensees, and which enables them to do successful work.
There is not, to my knowledge, one of the Robinson apparatus in use in the United States, and no one
has ever been able to successfully operate it, as the apparatus, without my processes, sinks and turns the to-
bacco so that all that have been tried have been rejected. I should like to find one in use, as that apparatus,
so far as the apparatus alone is concerned, infringes on my 1869 patent, and I shall prosecute any one whom I
may find using it.

In regard to the Sutter suit, it is proper to say that no judgment of any amount has yet been rendered.
Aside from that fact, it is to be remembered that the Sutter apparatus was constructed under a patent dated
June 15, 1880, while the rest of my licensees use the 1869 apparatus, so that, whatever may be the result of

cess, it cannot be affected by the Robinson patent, as no suit for the use of it can be brought upon the Robin-
son or any other patent, nor could an injunction be issued restraining its continued use.
It will therefore be seen that, should a settlement be made under the Robinson patent, it would afford you
no protection, but on the contrary, would involve the parties making such settlement in a suit with me under
my 1869 patent. And, on the other hand, I am protecting every one of my licensees by defending them at my
own expense against suits brought under the Robinson patent, and affording them the most complete and
adequate protection which could possibly be given, by licensing them to use an apparatus far superior to the
Robinson, and patented long before it. I know my rights, and mean to maintain them, no matter what the
cost.
Only a few days ago Judge Blatchford refused them an injunction in the suit against me (and of course
would refuse one against any of my licensees), and after the refusal of this injunction, the Robinson Tobacco
Company offered to sell me their patent; but as I would not buy it, the object of their circular seems to me
to be to force me to buy a patent which is not worth the paper on which it is written.
I can leave it to the judgment of my licensees, upon this state of facts, to determine who is in the right,
and what course is best to be pursued under the circumstances.
Any other information can be obtained from me or my attorneys.
If a suit should be commenced against you for infringement of the Robinson patent, you are instructed
to turn over all papers relating to the same to me or my attorneys, and I will see that you are properly de-
fended at my expense.
