

UNITED STATES OF AMERICA.

STATE OF FLORIDA, COUNTY OF HILLSBOROUGH.

Be it Remembered, That on the 13th day of October, A.D. 1900,
Emanuel Roberts late of *Great Britain*, at present of
Hillsborough, County, Florida, appeared in the Circuit Court of the Sixth Judicial Circuit of Florida, and
applied to said Court to be admitted to become a citizen of the United States of America; and it appearing to
the Court by the testimony of *L. E. Caro* and *Primes Jones*
of Hillsborough County, Florida, that said applicant has resided in the United States during the last five
years, and for the year last past has resided within the State of Florida; and it further appearing that
he made a declaration of his intention to become a citizen of the United States according to the statutes more
than two years since, and that he is over twenty-one years of age, and is in all other respects entitled to be-
come a naturalized citizen: It is therefore ordered that the said *Emanuel Roberts*
be allowed to take the oath of allegiance to the United States and become a citizen thereof.

Whereupon the said *Emanuel Roberts* takes the oath of allegiance required
by law and is admitted and adjudged to be a naturalized citizen of the United States of America.
