Annual Report 1986

This number of North American Bird Bander contains WBBAs *Annual Report* of banding activity during 1986, within the arbitrarily defined limits of the territory assigned to Western Bird Banding Association. We are again most grateful to Joan Tweit for gathering, organizing and compiling this sectional material. We are grateful too, for the aid of individual banders and banding stations in providing responses to Joan's request for a tally of their banding activities. The success and meaningfulness of the *Annual Report* depend on this aid. The apparent quantitative dominance of waterfowl banding records is at least partly due to the greater attention based upon large sponsored programs. This contrasts with the more variable support for, and usually more fragmentary nature of, banding of representatives of most other groups of birds, perhaps especially passerines.
