Be it resolved by the Senate of the University of South Florida Student Government assembled,

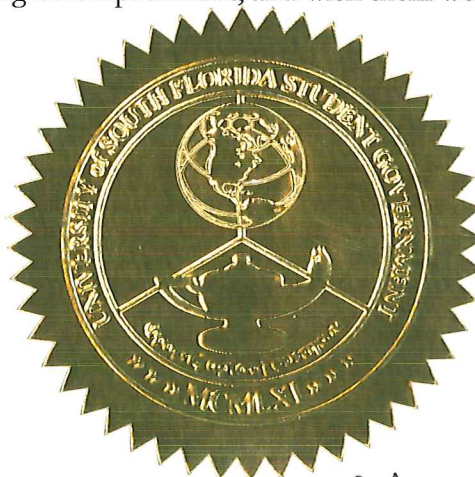


