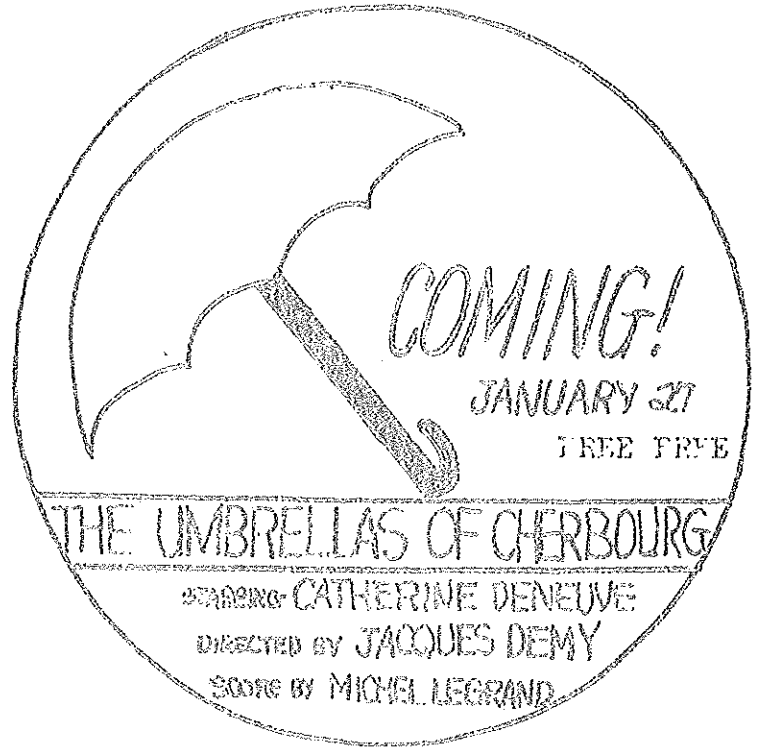

What is the enrollment at USF's St. Petersburg Campus for Quarter II?

Our administrative sources state that there is a 10% increase in course registrations this quarter, boosting previous figures to 1700. (Each course a student takes counts as one course registration.) There are approximately 1,000 countable heads on campus and about twenty students per class utilize USFSP's ninety offerings. Thirty per cent of the SP student body attend sessions on both Tampa and St. Petersburg campuses. This general upsurge contrasts with the fact that most colleges decrease enrollment in January, as many students withdraw after the Winter Quarter.
