The intent of this legislation is to update statutes to reflect the current needs and concerns of the Lakeland student experience.

A SENATE STATUTORY AMENDMENT

Be it enacted by the Senate of the University of South Florida Student Government assembled, that the following changes be made to the Student Government Statutes:

Chapter

308

Department of Lakeland Affairs ~~Student Council~~¹

~~308.1—This chapter shall not be removed as long as there are University of South Florida students participating in the teach-out at the USF Lakeland Campus.~~

~~308.1.1—This chapter must be reviewed for necessary changes, at minimum, during the Spring Semester.²~~

~~308.9.1.1—The Student Body President must call a review committee to order no later than the third Friday in January of their applicable term.~~

~~308.1.1.1.1—The review committee must at minimum include the following members:~~

~~308.1.1.1.1.1—The Student Body President~~

~~308.1.1.1.1.2—The Chief Financial Officer~~

~~308.1.1.1.1.3 The Attorney General~~

~~308.1.1.1.1.4 A Representative of the Student Senate appointed by the Senate President~~

~~308.1.1.1.1.5 Two USF Lakeland Student Representatives~~

~~308.1.1.1.2 Any recommended changes to this chapter must be delivered in writing to the Senate President and Senate President Pro Tempore two (2) weeks prior to the last Senate meeting of the semester.~~

~~308.2~~308.1 There shall be a Department of Lakeland Affairs~~Student Council~~, comprised of one (1) Director of Lakeland Affairs and one (1) Assistant Director of Lakeland Affairs~~students enrolled at the USF Lakeland Teach-out site~~, for the purpose of organizing and providing student programming, student services, and any other student initiatives deemed appropriate by the Director of Lakeland Affairs, Assistant Director of Lakeland Affairs~~both the Lakeland Student Council~~ and the Student Body President.

~~308.3 The Lakeland Student Council shall be comprised of the following positions:~~

~~308.3.1 Governor~~

~~308.3.2 Lieutenant Governor~~

~~308.3.3 Treasurer~~

~~308.3.4 Secretary~~

~~308.3.5 Advisor on Student Life~~

~~308.3.6 Advisor on Programming~~

~~308.3.7 Deputy Advisor on Programming~~

~~308.4~~308.2 The duties and responsibilities of the positions that compromise the Department of Lakeland Affairs~~Student Council~~ shall be specified in the Executive Administrative Code.

~~308.5~~308.3 The Department of Lakeland Affairs~~Student Council members~~ shall be appointed by the Student Body President.

~~308.5.1~~308.3.1 The Department of Lakeland Affairs~~Student Council~~ member appointments shall be delivered to the Senate President for confirmation at the Senate's discretion.

~~308.5.2~~308.3.2 The Student Body President does not need to conduct a formal hiring process to appoint members to the Department of Lakeland Affairs~~Student Council~~.

~~308.6~~308.4 Any member of the Department~~Governor~~ of the Lakeland Affairs~~Student Council~~ may only be removed by the Student Body President with justifiable cause via written memo and with a majority vote of the Senate.~~with two-thirds (2/3) consent of the Senate.~~

~~308.7~~308.5 The Department of Lakeland Affairs~~Student Council~~ shall be responsible for reporting to the Student Body President at least once every two (2) weeks.

~~308.7.1 The manner and frequency of which such reports shall take place shall be specified in the Executive Administrative Code.~~

~~308.8~~ The Lakeland Student Council shall be responsible for creating Standard Operating Procedures.

~~308.8.1~~ The Standard Operating Procedures shall be submitted to the Student Body President and Senate President for approval from the appropriate Senate oversight committee by the end of the Summer semester.

~~308.8.2~~ The Standard Operating Procedures shall specify the manner in which Student Organizations at the USF Lakeland Teach-out site qualify for and may request funding.

~~308.8.2.1~~ Lakeland Student Organizations shall still submit their constitutions for review to the appropriate Senate oversight committee.

~~308.9~~308.6 The Department of Lakeland Affairs~~Student Council~~ shall be responsible for creating an interim~~annual~~ allocation request to the Student Body President.

~~308.9.1~~308.6.1 The Student Body President shall recommend an interim~~annual~~ allocation for the Department of Lakeland Affairs~~Student Council~~ no later than the second Friday of the Fall semester.~~in June.~~

~~308.9.1.1~~ The Department of Lakeland Affairs~~Student Council~~ shall submit an interim~~annual~~ budget request to the Student Body President no later than the fourth Friday in July~~May~~.

~~308.9.2~~ The Lakeland Student Council shall be able to submit interim allocation requests for additional funding when deemed appropriate by the Student Body President and the Lakeland Student Council Governor.

~~308.9.2.1~~ The interim requests for funding from the Department of Lakeland Affairs~~Student Council~~ shall not be subject to any late penalties.

~~308.9.2.2~~ The process for requesting additional funding shall be outlined in the Executive Administrative Code.
