You've decided to write an article in your "spare time." With 10 years of data you estimate a three month effort to compile the numbers and calculate the statistics. With another month to draw the graphs and write the article, it might be published this year.

At the Coyote Creek Riparian Station in California, Mike Rigney makes a decision to write an article. Two days later his data is turned into useful information and graphics. He writes an article in less than a month.

The Coyote Creek Riparian Station was the first banding station in the United States to install "The Bander." Using the incredibly powerful CROSSTAB and TALLY commands on his banding database, Mike is able to compile data and statistics in a matter of minutes.

"The Bander" is an R:base program developed by BC Software in co-operation with Dr. Richard Mewaldt and Michael Rigney of the Coyote Creek Riparian Station. Due to the massive amount of data accumulated over 25 years of banding, Dr. Mewaldt visualized a computer program that would:

- require little or no training to use,
- allow simple and fast data entry,
- verify data validity on entry,
- produce Bird Banding Laboratory Report information,
- provide mathematical and analytical functions,
- support reliable archival storage of all data, and
- print useful summary reports.

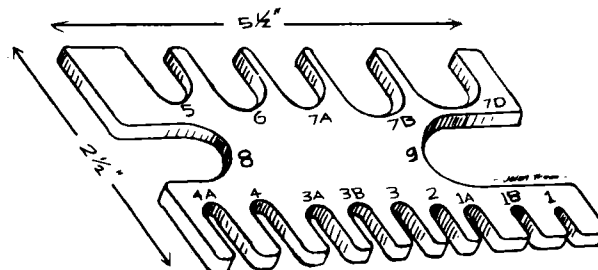
