To Any Minister of the Gospel or any
Officer legally authorized to solemnize
the Rite of Matrimony;

Whereas: Application having been
made to the County Judge of Hills-
borough County, of the State of Florida,
for a License for Marriage, and it
appearing to the satisfaction of said
County Judge that no legal impediments
exist to the marriage now
sought to be solemnized, These are
therefore to authorize you to unite
in the Holy Estate of Matrimony
Perico Bentacur and Severina Ruiz,
And that you make return
of the same duly certified under
your hand, to the County Judge
aforesaid,

Court House in Tampa this 23rd
day of December, AD 1889.
