The following records are presented to highlight interesting recoveries and recaptures that have resulted from banding projects. We hope the reports show how different banders are using the data generated through their projects. This column presents an opportunity for banders to share unusual records with other banders. Some of the reports, such as the longevities, reported here may be significant advances in our knowledge; however, for a listing of longevity records verified by the Bird Banding Laboratory, see the papers cited in Klimkiewicz and Fitcher (1989) *J. Field Ornithol.* 60:469-494.

## I. NON-PASSERINES

**Short-tailed Albatross** 558-30754 Banded as a L-U on Torishima Island, Japan by the Yamashina Inst. Ornithology on 10 Mar 1964. Encountered by Robert Sakahora on Midway Atoll, NW Hawaiian Islands during the winter of 1972-1973. Resighted on Midway Atoll by Eugene Kridler on 19 Nov 1973, and again by Palmer Sekora on 7 Nov 1974. [Midway is 4240 km E of banding site. Kridler reports that the bird's plumage was still more similar to an immature than an adult, even though it was over 9 yrs old.]

**Black-crowned Night-Heron** 1337-84427 Banded as L-U by staff of High Peaks Audubon Society at Four Brothers Islands, Lake Champlain NY on 11 June 1988. Shot at Praia da Vitoria, Island of Terceira, Azores, off the coast of Portugal, on 16 Oct 1988; about 4000 km ESE of banding site. [First recovery of a banded Black-crowned Night-Heron in Europe, see *NABB* 6:88-96 & *NABB* 12:11-12.]

... 1007-49605 Banded as L-U by Dick Mewaldt at Redwood City CA on 12 July 1973. Found dead in Palo Alto CA on 1 Jan 1988. 15 years old.

**American White Pelican** 619-01359 Banded as L-U by Ronald Ryder at Riverside Reservoir CO on 13 Jul 1981. Found dead at Ingleside TX on 30 Jan 1988. 7 years old.

**Mallard** 917-77730 Banded as HY-M by Ronald Ryder at Ft. Collins CO on 11 Sept 1986. Shot near Camrose AB on 22 Sept 1988, about 1500 km NW of banding site.

... 1467-80269 Banded as AHY-M by Ronald Ryder at Ft. Collins CO on 19 Apr 1987. Shot at Downing TX on 16 Jan 1988.

... 1467-09371 Banded as HY-M by members of the California Waterfowl Association at Gray Lodge Wildlife Area CA on 27 June 1987. Found dead at Wilson WY on 9 May 1988.

... 1467-44898 Banded as HY-M by members of the California Waterfowl Association at Gray Lodge Wildlife Area CA on 8 Aug 1987. Killed as banding casualty at Deer Flat NWR, ID on 12 Sept 1988.

**Cinnamon Teal** 525-69912 Banded as HY-M by members of the California Waterfowl Association on Grizzly Island, Suisun CA on 28 July 1987. Shot in Ensenada, Baja California Norte, Mexico on 27 Feb 1988, about 850 km SE of banding site.

**Gadwall** 696-29538 Banded as L-F by Ronald Ryder at Ft. Collins CO on 24 Aug 1987. Shot at Zacatecas, Zacatecas, Mexico, in Jan 1988, about 2200 km S of banding site.

**Northern Pintail** 686-43523 Banded as AHY-F by Ronald Ryder at Ft. Collins CO on 14 Feb 1987. Shot at Wade OK on 6 Jan 1988, about 1100 km SE of banding site.

... 836-98486 Banded as AHY-M by Ernie Kuyt at Wood Buffalo Natl. Park, Canada on 19 Aug 1977. Shot at Culiacan, Sinaloa, Mexico on 16 Jan 1987, about 3750 km SE of banding site.

**Redhead** 946-84576 Banded as HY-M by Ronald Ryder at Meska SK on 10 Aug 1987. Live-trapped at Wellington CO on 21 Aug 1988, about 1400 km S of banding site.

... 776-54397 Banded as AHY-M by Ronald Ryder at Ft. Collins CO on 30 Mar 1988. Shot near Leroy SK on 14 Oct 1988, about 1500 km N of banding site.

**Canvasback** 1027-13381 Banded as U-M by personnel of the Oakland Parks and Recreation Dept. at Oakland CA on 21 Dec 1976. Shot there on 2 Jan 1988. At least 12 years old.

**Harlequin Duck** 655-07208 Banded as AHY-M by Rick Wallen at Berry Creek, Teton Co., WY on 7 June 1985. Recaptured in Teton Co. on 6 June 1988. [One of four 4-year-old males recaptured in 1988.]

**Osprey** 608-23486 Banded as L-U by B. Woodbridge at Eagle Lake CA on 18 July 1980. Found dead there by Pete Bloom on 8 June 1988. 8 years old.

... 608-36048 Banded as L-U by Jeffrey Hughes at Talkeetna AK on 2 Aug 1985. Found dead entangled in fishing gear at Guadalajara, Jalisco, Mexico on 21 Feb 1988, about 5600 km SE of banding site.

**Bald Eagle** 629-10973 Banded as ATY-F by Gregory Toffic in Poulsbo WA on 11 Apr 1987. Flew into a bridge in Apple Cove WA on 30 Jan 1988.

**Sharp-shinned Hawk** 1373-86376 Banded as HY-F by Stephen Hoffman in the Goshute Mountains NV on 12 Sept 1987. Shot in Guamuchil, Sinaloa, Mexico on 19 Nov 1987, about 1800 km SE of banding site.

... 1493-20318 Banded as HY-F by Stephen Hoffman in the Goshute Mountains NV on 7 Sept 1987. Found dead at Flathead Lake MT on 15 Aug 1988, about 800 km N of banding site.

... 1343-02164 Banded as HY-F by Stephen Hoffman in the Goshute Mountains NV on 6 Sept 1987. Shot in Agauje Badiraguato, Mexico on 31 Jan 1988.

**Red-tailed Hawk** 877-50020 Banded as a L-U by Jack Kirkley at Richmond UT on 8 Jun 1980. Found dead at Midland TX on 13 Sept 1986; about 1440 km SE of banding site. 6 years old.

... 877-31725 Banded as AHY-U by Pete Bloom at Bridgeport CA on 9 Nov 1975. Found dead at Tule Lake CA on 5 Jan 1988, about 460 km NW of banding site. At least 14 years old.

**Swainson's Hawk** 987-62889 Banded as L-U by B. Woodbridge at Dorris CA on 7 July 1987. Found dead at Culiacan, Sinaloa, Mexico in June 1988, about 2500 km SE of banding site.

**American Kestrel** 1373-38054 Banded as AHY-F by Norman Hogg at Indio CA on 10 Nov 1985. Killed by car in Geona NV on 14 June 1988, about 650 km N of banding site.

**Peregrine Falcon** 987-24001 Banded as L-F by personnel of the Alberta Fish and Wildl. Division in Wood Buffalo Natl. Park AB on 24 June 1988. Injured at Big Lake TX on 10 Nov 1988, about 3400 km SE of banding site.

**Northern Harrier** 745-51010 Banded as SY-F by Katy Duffy at Sandy Hook, Gateway Nat. Rec. Area NJ on 24 Apr 1981. Found dead by Charles Singer at Kennetcook Hants NS on 7 May 1989; about 760 km NE of banding site. 10 years old.

**American Coot** 976-73077 Banded as AHY-U by Ronald Ryder at Ft. Collins CO on 14 Sept 1987. Found dead in Tillman County OK on 17 Jan 1988, about 800 km SE of banding site.

**Piping Plover** 691-80677 Female banded by P.C. Peterson at Vermillion SD on 1 July 1966. Found dead there by Mr. & Mrs. Charles Rogge on 25 May 1974. At least 8 years old.

**Semipalmated Sandpiper** 1231-84309 Banded as HY-U by Dave Smith of the Canadian Wildlife Service at Vancouver BC on 16 Aug 1987. Killed by collision with wires in Guyana on 20 Oct 1987, about 7300 km SE of banding site.

**Least Sandpiper** 1151-82986 Banded as HY-U by Dave Smith of the Canadian Wildlife Service at

Vancouver BC on 30 July 1987. Shot at Laguna Larga, Mexico on 15 Oct 1987.

**Ring-billed Gull** 595-56974 Banded as AHY-U by D.F. Martin at Moses Lake WA on 6 May 1973. Found by W.R. Radke at Potholes Reservoir WA on 29 June 1988. At least 16 years old. [Wing broken.]

... 734-59731 Banded as L-U by Alan Gubanich and Hugh Judd at Lake Lahontan NV on 13 June 1987. Seen by Reggie David on Kailua-Kona HA on 6 Dec 1987, about 5500 km SW of banding site. [Identified using a spotting scope.]

**Caspian Tern** 755-94758 Banded as L-U by Dick Mewaldt at Drawbridge CA on 8 July 1971. Died of injuries at Daly City CA on 29 Apr 1988. 17 years old.

**Black Noddy** 662-05536 Banded as a breeding bird (recorded as AHY-U) by Eugene Kridler at Midway Atoll, NW Hawaiian Islands on 27 Feb 1964. Found dead there by B. Premothilaka on 8 Dec 1988. [Since Black Noddies usually breed in their third (sometimes second) year, this bird was probably at least 26 years, 10 months old. according to Kridler and Roger Clapp. New longevity record; previous record 21 yr 9 mo, J. Field Ornithol. 60:482.]

**Mourning Dove** 1373-89410 Banded as HY-F by Phil Walters at Tucson AZ on 23 June 1983. Shot at Loreta, Baja California Sur, Mexico on 2 Jan 1988, about 700 km S of banding site.

... 1493-06108 Banded as HY-F by Phil Walters at Tucson AZ on 2 Aug 1987. Shot in Jalisco Mexico on 7 Mar 1988, about 1450 km SE of banding site.

**White-winged Dove** 644-96343 Banded as AHY-U by Ross Chapin in Tucson AZ on 17 May 1987. Recovered in Mixtepec Juquila, Oaxaca, Mexico on 9 Dec. 1987.

... 644-96400 Banded as HY-U by Ross Chapin in Tucson AZ on 19 July 1987. Recovered in Iguala, Guerrero, Mexico, about 1900 km SE of banding site.

**Flammulated Owl** 1373-33614 Banded as L-U by Richard Reynolds at Teller County CO on 15 July 1981. Recaptured at the nest there on 7 Oct 1988. 7 years, 4 months old. [New longevity record, see J. Field Ornithol. 61:243-244.]

**Blue-throated Hummingbirds** x-44970 and x-44994 Banded as HY-M by David Ferry at Ramsey Canyon AZ on 18 July 1988 and 4 Sept 1988, respectively. Both recaptured at Madera Canyon AZ on 25 July 1988 and 5 Sept 1988, respectively. [Ramsey and Madera Canyons are @60 km apart. The only previous bird captured at both sites by Dave Ferry was a Berylline Hummingbird in 1987 (see NABB 14:15). The 2 captures of x-44994 were only 27 hours apart.]

**Calliope Hummingbird** x-TTB Banded as AHY-F by Bill Calder at Gothic CO on 24 May 1983. Recaptured by Elly Jones at Condon MT on 24 July 1988. At least 6 years, 1 month old. [New longevity record, see J. Field Ornithol. 60:484. Record has been tied by second bird banded by Calder and recaptured by Jones in 1989.]

**Broad-tailed Hummingbird** x-27961 Banded as AHY-M by Bill Calder at Gothic CO in 1982. Retrapped there by Natasha Kotliar on 1 June 1988. At least 6 years old.

**Rufous Hummingbird** T-12826 Banded as HY-F by Elly Jones at Swan Lake MT on 30 July 1988. Recaptured by Bill Calder at Gothic CO on 9 Aug 1988, about 1140 km S of banding site. [Traveled in 10 days.]

**Ladder-backed Woodpecker** 921-03818 Banded by AHY-M by Phil Walters at Tucson AZ on 27 June 1985. Found dead by Donald Miles in the Rincon Mountains (near Tucson) on 29 July 1988. 4 years, 2 months old. [4 months short of longevity record.]

## II. PASSERINES

**Great Crested Flycatcher** 861-63035 Banded as AHY-U by Annette Flanigan-Stedman and Stanley Stedman at Casey Key FL on 20 Apr 1979. Renetted there on 18 April 1984. Two previous encounters; at least 6 years old.

**Gray Jay** 1163-20900 Banded as U-U by Thomas Nicholls at the Fraser Expt. Forest, Grand Co., CO on 25 Aug 1982. Renetted there on 24 Aug 1988. 6 years old; 8 previous recaptures.

... 1423-91906 Banded as AHY-U by Thomas Nicholls at the Fraser Expt. Forest, Grand Co. CO on 6 Sept 1982. Renetted there on 24 Aug 1988. 7 years old; 3 previous recaptures.

**Blue Jay** 1173-16659 Banded as ASY-U by Annette Flanigan at Waite Hill OH on 14 May 1975. Found dead at Bells TN on 19 Jan 1978; about 900 km S of banding site.

... 612-30583 Banded as AHY-U by W.A. Dunbar at Watkinsville GA on 10 May 1984. Shot by farmer on 10 May 1989 within 0.5 km of banding site. At least 6 years old.

... 1063-67149 Banded by Mr. & Mrs. Charles Rogge at Sioux Falls SD on 24 Sept 1972. Recovered there by Dilwyn Rogers on 30 Aug 1982. At least 10 years old.

...1163-18874 Banded as HY-U by Joseph Mahoney at Great Swamp NWR, NJ on 4 Oct 1983. Eaten by a snake in Georgia 5 km N of the Florida state line on 17 Apr 1984. [Bander reports that this is the southernmost recovery of a NJ-banded Blue Jay.]

**Steller's Jay** 1433-30506 Banded by Elly Jones at Swan Lake MT on 3 Mar 1985. Recaptured there on 19 Feb 1990. At least 6 years old.

**House Wren** 1590-50582 Banded by Annette Flanigan-Stedman and Stanley Stedman at Casey Key FL on 27 Oct 1982. Renetted there on 11 March 1989. Six previous encounters, at least 7 years old.

**Ruby-crowned Kinglet** 1350-94648 Banded by Annette Flanigan at Waite Hill OH on 25 Apr 1975. Found dead at Dalton GA on 1 Apr 1976; about 800 km S of banding site.

**Western Bluebird** 1361-38249 Banded as L-M by Elsie Eltzroth near Corvallis OR on 15 July 1986. Shot there on 19 May 1988. [Hawks and gulls are not the only birds to meet their end by getting shot.]

**Mountain Bluebird** 991-05204 Banded as L-U by Donald Stiles near Calgary AB on 23 June 1986. Found alive in a fireplace and released near Lloydminster AB on 8 June 1988, about 370 km E of banding site.

... 961-61248 Banded as L-U by Donald Stiles near Calgary AB on 22 June 1986. Recovered in northern New Mexico in 1986, about 1800 km SE of banding site.

... 921-12553 Banded as L-F by Myrna Pearman near Edmonton AB on 14 June 1983. Recaptured in nestbox 1.5 km away on 18 May 1989. 5 years, 11 months old. [New longevity record; old record was 4 years, 10 months, see J. Field Ornithol. 54:290.]

**Hermit Thrush** 1311-65403 Banded as HY-U by Thomas Pogson at Fairbanks AK on 4 Sept 1982. Killed by collision with window there on 7 Sept 1987. Five years old.

**Veery** 1221-80661 Banded as AHY-F by Hannah Suthers at Hopewell NJ on 3 July 1980. Renetted there on 2 July 1989. At least 10 years, 1 month old. [New longevity record; previous record 8 yr 11 mo, J. Field Ornithol 54:290.]

...1221-89233 Banded as HY-U by D. Schwab at Great Swamp NWR, NJ on 1 Sept 1979. Recaptured there by Joseph Mahoney in May 1988. 8 years, 11 months old; one previous recapture. [Ties longevity record, see J. Field Ornithol. 54:290.]

**Gray Catbird** 901-16827 Banded by Annette Flanigan-Stedman and Stanley Stedman at Casey Key FL on 7 April 1986. Found dead at Cutts Island ME on 6 June 1986; about 2080 km NE of banding site.

... 861-63118 Banded by Annette Flanigan-Stedman and Stanley Stedman at Casey Key FL on 15 Oct 1979. Found dead at Banner Elk NC on 1 Aug 1983; about 1000 km N of banding site.

...781-25046 Banded by Annette Flanigan at Waite Hill OH on 1 Oct 1972. Found dead on GA/FL border on 16 Oct 1972; about 1300 km S of banding site. [Traveled in 16 days.]

... 691-75868 Banded by Charles Rogge at Oakwood Lakes St. Park, near Bruce SD on 1 June 1967. Renetted there on 25 June 1973. At least 6 years old.

**Brown Thrasher** 862-13040 Banded by Annette Flanigan-Stedman and Stanley Stedman at Casey Key FL on 19 Sept 1980. Renetted there on 18 Feb 1987. At least 7 years old.

**Loggerhead Shrike** 921-31364 Banded as L-U by Doug Collister at Princess AB on 13 June 1987. Retrapped as breeding AHY-F at Cavendish AB on 19 June 1989; 70 km NE of banding site. [Three L-U banded in June 1988 were retrapped as breeding adult males in 1989 within 6 km of banding sites.]

**Solitary Vireo** 54-52811 Banded as AHY-U by Annette Flanigan-Stedman and Stanley Stedman at Casey Key FL on 13 Feb 1980. Renetted there on 19 Feb 1985. Two previous encounters, at least 5 years old.

**Warbling Vireo** 860-49417 Banded by Mr. & Mrs. Charles Rogge at Newton Hills St. Park, Canton, SD on 3 Aug 1981. Recovered by Concepcion Morales at El Elpalmar Cito TN Famanique, El Salvador on 9 Feb 1982; about 3520 km S of banding site.

**Red-eyed Vireo** 950-86887 Banded as AHY-U by Marguerite Solomon at the Lake of the Ozarks near Sunrise Beach MO on 8 May 1983. Recaptured there on 11 May 1988. Five previous encounters, at least 6 years old. [One of 11 migrant Red-eyed Vireos banded in a three-day period in May 1983. Seven of the 11 have been recaptured in subsequent years, always in the same two net lanes and always between 29 Apr to 12 May of each year.]

**Yellow Warbler** 1590-07496 Banded as AHY-U by John Peterson at Port Henry NY on 14 May 1983. Renetted there on 20-21 May 1989. At least 7 years old.

**Magnolia Warbler** 1440-56685 Banded as AHY-M by Annette Flanigan at Waite Hill OH on 2 Sept 1976. Killed by boy with slingshot at Nueva Santa Rosa, Guatemala on 10 Oct 1976. About 3200 km S of banding site.

**Cape May Warbler** 860-15611 Banded by Annette Flanigan at Waite Hill OH on 17 Sept 1975. Caught by cat at Bedford, QB on 27 Sept 1978; about 800 km NE of banding site.

... 1780-40572 Banded as HY-F by Doug Collister at Matlock MB on 23 Aug 1988. Found dead near Alma WI on 29 Aug 1988; about 800 km SE of banding site. [Traveled in 6 days.]

**Yellow-rumped Warbler** 1780-40147 Banded as AHY-U by Doug Collister at Matlock MB on 22 Aug 1987. Caught by dog near Campbell WI on 11 May 1989; 820 km SE of banding site.

... 1720-56741 Banded as HY-M by Bill Hilton at York SC on 2 Nov 1986. Found dead at Ambrose Lake ON in April 1987; about 1760 km NW of banding site.

... 1620-66227 Banded as AHY-M by Peter Homann at Tallahassee FL on 5 Dec 1982. Recaptured there on 4 Mar 1990. At least 8 years, 9 months old. 15 previous encounters. [New longevity record, beating old record by almost 2 years, see J. Field Ornithol. 54:292.]

**Blackpoll Warbler** 1420-75144 Banded by Annette Flanigan at Waite Hill OH on 17 Sept 1975. Renetted at Kiptopeke Beach VA on 24 Oct 1975; about 670 km SE of banding site. [Only one other Blackpoll has been banded and retrapped at a different location in the same season, according to BBL records.]

**Common Yellowthroat** 1480-93423 Banded as an AHY-M by Elise Lapham on Block Island RI on 27 Aug 1980. Renetted there on 25 Sept 1989. At least 10 years, 3 months old. [New longevity record, previous record 9 yr 11 mo, J. Field Ornithol. 54:293.]

**Hooded Warbler** 1780-54475 Banded as HY-M by Bill Hilton at York SC on 18 Aug 1987. Renetted at Chapel Hill NC on 27 May 1988; about 200 km NE of banding site.

**Summer Tanager** 941-00177 Banded as ASY-F by Phil Walters at Tucson AZ on 28 Apr 1983. Recaptured there on 30 June 1988. At least 7 years

old. [Only 3 months shy of longevity record, see J. Field Ornithol. 60:490.]

**Indigo Bunting** 990-18706 Banded by Annette Flanigan-Stedman and Stanley Stedman at Casey Key FL on 9 Jan 1984. Trapped and released by a Canadian bander on Andros Island, Bahamas on 29 Dec 1984; 540 km SE of banding site. Found dead at Cape St. Mary's NS on 26 May 1986; about 2400 km NE of banding site. [This bunting was one of a very few birds banded in the US or Canada that have been recovered in the Bahamas.]

... 810-64409 Banded by Annette Flanigan at Waite Hill OH on 6 Sept 1972. Found dead at Ada MI on 2 Aug 1973; 290 km NW of banding site.

**Lazuli Bunting** 1590-00180 Banded as SY-M by Merlin Killpack at Ogden UT on 17 May 1981. Retrapped there on 2 May 1988. At least 7 years old.

... 940-80744 Banded as SY-M by Joseph Jeppson at Pocatello ID on 26 May 1981. Retrapped there on 3 May 1988. [Ties longevity record of 8 years, 11 months. See J. Field Ornithol. 60:490.]

**American Tree Sparrow** 870-48475 Banded by Annette Flanigan at Waite Hill OH on 10 Dec 1975. Found dead at Grove City PA on 28 Mar 1979; about 125 km E of banding site.

**Song Sparrow** 1311-76143 Banded as HY-U by Breck Tyler at Santa Cruz CA on 9 June 1982. Recaptured there on 26 Nov 1988. 6 years old.

**White-crowned (Nuttall's) Sparrow** 1311-22592 Banded as AHY-U by Breck Tyler at Santa Cruz CA on 2 Nov 1981. Recaptured there on 26 Nov 1988. 8 years old.

... (Gambel's) 1351-65472 Banded as HY-U at San Jose CA on 14 Oct 1987. Brought to K. Voget after being killed by cat in Lakeview OR on 28 Sept 1988, about 550 km N of banding site.

... (Gambel's) 1211-21969 Banded as HY-U by Charles Corchran at Tucson AZ on 8 Nov 1979. Recaptured there on 10 Nov 1988. 9 years old.

**Dark-eyed (Oregon) Junco** 1610-46813 Banded by Elly Jones at Swan Lake MT on 13 Jan 1982. Recaptured there on 31 Mar 1990. At least 8 years old.

**Yellow-eyed Junco.** The following birds were banded by Kim Sullivan and field assistants at Rustler Park, Chiricahua Mountains AZ:

... 2010-19736 AHY-F banded on 5 June 1984, recaptured there on 9 May 1989. At least 6 years old.

... 940-92682 AHY-F color-banded on 25 June 1985, resighted there on 18 May 1989. At least 5 years old.

... 1590-72371 AHY-M color-banded on 29 May 1985, resighted there on 13 May 1989. At least 5 years old. [In addition, 4 birds banded as HY or L in 1984 were sighted in 1989, all are now 5 years old.]

**Common Grackle** 813-46995 Banded by Charles Rogge at Oakwood Lakes St. Park near Bruce SD on 27 Apr 1967. Renetted there on 18 May 1976. At least 10 years old.

**Brown-headed Cowbird** 841-24091 Banded by Annette Flanigan at Waite Hill OH on 19 Oct 1974. Retrapped at Franklinville NY on 5 May 1975, about 270 km NE of banding site.
