Now in its fifth year, the Monitoring Avian Productivity and Survivorship (MAPS) program is a cooperative, constant-effort mist-netting program established by The Institute for Bird Populations (see News, Notes, Comments this issue). The Institute is attempting to enlist an additional 34 MAPS stations in the Southwest Region and 13 in the Alaska Region to reach totals of 40 and 20 stations, respectively, operating in those regions in 1993. The methodology used by the MAPS program is simple and straightforward, and the program provides an excellent opportunity for Western banders to make an important contribution to avian biomonitoring.
