The White-crowned Sparrow featured in the logo is one of the most commonly banded passerines in the Western region. WBBA undertook a joint project on this species and many members have published their research results on WCSP. Thus, the White-crowned Sparrow has been part of the activities of WBBA throughout the Association's existence and is a most fitting emblem.
