The Ethics Bowl is a debate-style competition in which university teams respond to moral questions arising out of current events. The top four out of 20 teams in each regional competition are invited to participate in the national bowl.

The Ethics Bowl allows students to develop tools that are transferable to all industries, careers and walks-of-life. They learn how to organize, present and defend an argument, analyze a real-world moral dilemma, discuss difficult issues with respect and build confidence in their leadership skills.

"I was terrible at public speaking before being on the Ethics Bowl Team," said Marcus Rubenstein, a junior accounting major. "Now, I'm better at analyzing moral dilemmas, forming arguments, and presenting them clearly and confidently."
