## **ANNUAL REPORT**

This issue of *North American Bird Bander* contains the 1997 WBBA Annual Report. WBBA thanks Chris Otahal and the Coyote Creek Riparian Station for compiling the report and 250 banders who reported their data.

The report is arranged in the new AOU order so shrikes and vireos now appear before corvids. Some highlights of the report are: almost 200,000 birds of 441 full species were reported in 1997. Almost 30% of the total was banded in California and over 10% of the birds banded were Mallards. Significant numbers of passerines including Wil-

son's, Yellow-rumped (all forms), and Orange-crowned warblers, Tree Swallow, Western and Mountain bluebirds, Swainson's Thrush, Ruby-crowned Kinglet, Song Sparrow, and House Finch were banded. Low numbers of Mourning and Inca doves were surprising. Browse through the report; it's full of fascinating data.
