While banders in the western United States capture mainly those species we think of as "Western," our colleagues in Alberta and the Northern Territories are within the breeding range of many species traditionally considered as "Eastern." Add to these the endemic and semi-endemic sea and land birds from Hawaii and Alaska and the strays that wander to the Farrallon Islands, and you can understand the wide diversity presented on the following pages.

WBBA is very grateful to Chris Otahal for compiling this report and to the banders who sent their 1998 results. Chris is continuing to compile our Annual Report even though his former employer, Coyote Creek Riparian Station, no longer exists.
