Jennie Slater of Thornton, CO, was one of the first women hired by the Colorado Division of Wildlife, which she joined immediately after graduating from Colorado State University in 1976. Her career with the Division culminated in her appointment last year as Acting Coordinator for Prairie Ecosystems in the Division's newly created section devoted to threatened and endangered species. She also wrote and implemented Colorado's Least Tern and Piping Plover recovery plans. She was passionate not only about wildlife and conservation but also about sports and photography.
