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# 2002 ANNUAL BANDING REPORT

The following summary of banding activity in the WBBA region in 2002 testifies both to the diversity of the region and to the dedication of its banders. The total of 212,330 birds banded is up 13% from 2001, down 2% from 2000, and up 8% from 1999 and 1998. The mean number of birds banded by each permit holder was 1,173, compared to 796 in 2001, 928 in 2000, 838 in 1999, and 801 in 1998. Whether this increase was due to higher capture rates, increased effort, or a lower response rate from small banding operations is unclear.

I notice that while the number of active banders reporting varied from 234 to 246 for 1998-2001, only 181 reported for 2002. I hope this is not the start of a trend! I believe that this reflects merely a drop in reporting rather than a drop in banding. The Annual Report is one of the most valuable services WBBA provides the banding community – in fact, the other associations may soon follow suit – and we need the participation of all the banders in the region. Please, when you receive a request from us for your banding totals, provide them!! We cannot do this without your help.

As always, we extend our heartfelt thanks and appreciation to Chris Otahal for the Herculean – and unpaid – task of compiling this report. We also thank Rita Colwell for her help with proofing. And, of course, we thank all the banders who reported their totals and we salute their efforts.
