ASHLAND MEETING 2004

Glorious weather, educational workshops, stimulating papers and presentations, and a wide selection of field trips helped to make our 79th annual meeting a huge success. Thanks are due to John Alexander and the staff and volunteers at Klamath Bird Observatory, who really outdid themselves in coordinating and producing this meeting held jointly with Western Field Ornithologists and Oregon Field Ornithologists.

The plumage and molt workshop with Peter Pyle was fully subscribed in advance, and received rave

reviews from participants. WBBA members not enrolled in that workshop were able to visit KBO's banding stations, where observation and assistance were welcomed. Steve Howell's hummingbird identification workshop helped banders and birders alike to separate similar species. And, as always, informal chats with colleagues in the hallways and during meals rounded out a fine weekend.

Selected abstracts from the meeting will be published in *NABB* 29(4).

Next year's meeting is scheduled for the first weekend in October in Camarillo, CA.

BIRDS BANDED in 2003: The WBBA Annual Report

The Western Bird Banding Association is extremely grateful to Chris Otahal for compiling the 2003 Annual Banding Report and to Ken Burton and Rita Colwell for helping with proofreading the final document. Compiling and proofreading this report takes an enormous amount of volunteer time and effort. We also thank all the banders that took time out of their busy lives to forward data to Chris. The number of banders reporting data, 179, was lower than 2002. Let us hope that trend does not continue. The annual report is an excellent resource that allows individuals to review the data collected by many dedicated banders in the WBBA region.

You will notice that the total birds banded, 178,089, is down from the 212,330 birds banded in 2002. In fact, if my quick review of past annual reports is correct, it is the lowest total count since 1998. The mean number of birds banded by each permit holder was down as well from 1,173 in 2002 to 895. However, the total number of species banded remained the same between 2003 and 2002 at 420. It is unclear whether this decrease in total number is due to a decrease in capture rate, due to decreased bander response, or a combination of both.

At the annual board meeting, we discussed ways to increase bander response for the annual report. We made the commitment to investigate developing a process to automate data submission. We hope that automated submissions will both decrease the time required to compile and proofread the report and, at the same time, increase the number of banders submitting data in the future.
