HIGHLIGHTS FROM THE ANNUAL MEETING

Grants – Humple reported that grants were awarded to

1. **Lena Usyk**, Central Michigan University; Project: The ecology of LeConte's Sparrows and other grassland birds at Munuscong Bay [Michigan].
2. **Lia Jacobsen Prellvitz and Raissa Iris de Carvalho**, Federal University of Rio Grande, Rio Grande do Sul, Brazil; Project: Breeding ecology of the Southern Black-backed Gull (*Larus dominicanus*) in Deserta Island, Arvoredo Marine Reserve, Santa Catarina, Brazil.

Membership – Burton reported that numbers continue to decline. He will survey former members to learn why they did not renew. We need to find ways to increase the value of membership for

existing members, so that they continue to remain a part of the organization. Blevins will solicit ideas on how we can better serve current members. Board members were urged to recruit new members.

NABC – Alexander reported that the Evaluation and Certification Committee has finished compiling the certification materials. Burton reported that the Education Committee is developing photographic keys for age and sex determination. The Board agreed to fund attendance of the Alternate at NABC meetings.

Website – It often takes a long time to get information posted to our website. Since timeliness is a priority, we may need to become more involved in keeping the website current. Online store has not been productive, and will be deleted from the website. Photo Gallery content needs closer monitoring to insure that pictures show proper bird handling techniques. Comment section has been abused, and hence must be disabled.

Storage of WBBA Documents – To qualify as a non-profit organization, we may be required to have printed records of our minutes. We need to find an effective way to store meeting minutes and other WBBA Documents. Alexander and Humple will explore possibilities for keeping records electronically.

2007 Meeting – Humple will host the 2007 annual meeting at PRBO Conservation Science in Petaluma, CA. Interest was expressed in offering bander training workshops alternating with NABC certification sessions at future meetings, beginning in 2007.

Editor – Loughman will resign after completing NABB 31(4). She will continue to work on enhancing access to SORA.
