

## IBBA Annual Report of Birds Banded, 2005

Summary of banding reported from the IBBA region for 2005 with USFWS/CWS bands.

This is the fourth consecutive year of this report. Forty-nine active banders reported banding 100,521 individuals of 343 species/forms. This represents the most species/forms reported by this region, and the total number of birds banded is similar to what was reported for three of the last four years. We received no reports from Iowa, Missouri, North Dakota or South Dakota. Texas banding represented 32% of the banding total and Ohio, 24%.
