***News from the Bird Banders and Western Bird Bander* Now Available Online**

We are pleased to announce that WBBA's early publications *News from the Bird Banders* and *Western Bird Bander* are now accessible through our website at:

This collection covers 2700+ printed pages, most produced with a manual typewriter and mimeograph machine. In WBBA's archival set, pages from the earliest issues are becoming yellow and brittle, so it was important that we find a way to preserve WBBA's written history. The pages were individually scanned, and saved by volume/year as searchable PDFs. Included with the collection is a combined Table of Contents, also a searchable PDF.

News from the Bird Banders (NFBB) began quarterly publication in 1926, immediately after the founding of the Western Bird Banding Association. NFBB continued through the beginning of 1961 when it was succeeded by *Western Bird Bander* (WBB). WBB was published 1961 - 1975, after which the Western and Eastern bird banding associations joined forces to produce *North American Bird Bander*. In 1981 the Inland Bird Banding Association became the third partner in the NABB publication.

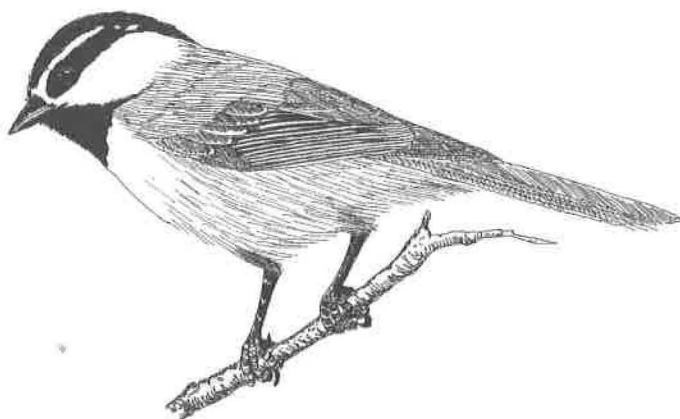
A CD containing the entire NFBB-WBB collection has been made available to libraries across the country whose catalogs show that they hold some portion of the print publications.
