Presentations are to be 20 minutes in length, including questions. **Abstract submission deadline is 1 Nov. Please** submit abstracts electronically as a MS Word document to:

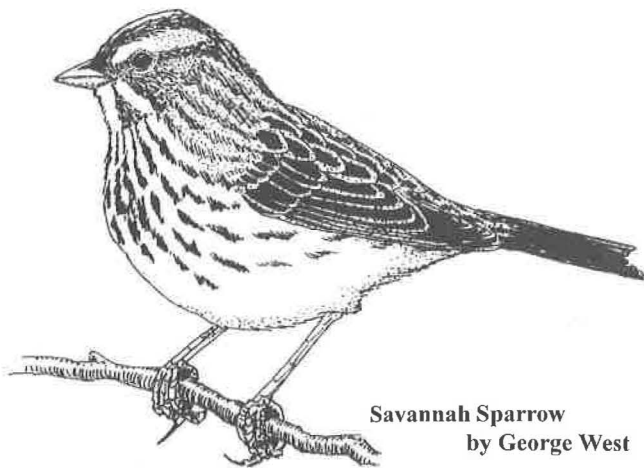
