marriage, and it appearing to the satis-

marriage now sought to be solemn-
ized, there are therefore authorizing you
to unite in the Holy Estate of Matrimony
Richard F. Clarke

and that you make return of this license
duly fulfilled under your hand, to the
County Judge aforesaid.
