To any Minister of the Gospel or any
Office Legally Authorized to solemn-
ize the Rite of Matrimony:

Whereas Application having been
made to the County Judge of Hillsborough
County in the State of Florida for a
License for Marriage, and it appearing
to the satisfaction of said County
Judge that no legal impediment
exists to the Marriage now sought
to be solemnized, there are therefore

to authorize you to unite in the
Holy Rite of Matrimony
Francisco Fernandez

and
Blanca Fernandez

and that you make return of the
same, duly certified under your hand
to the County Judge aforesaid.
