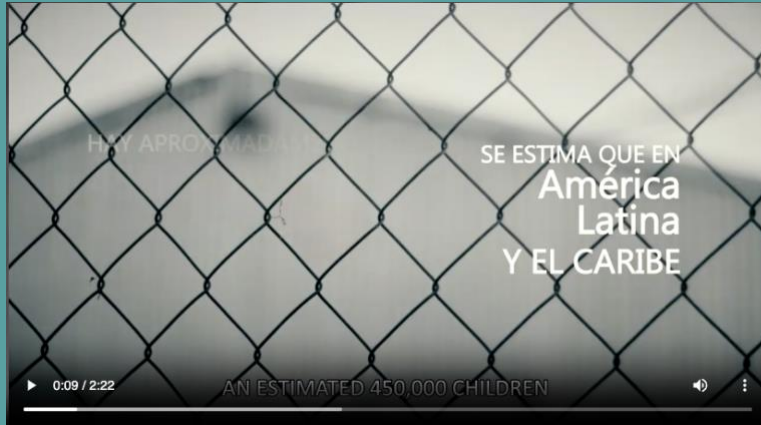
children choose not to talk about their stress because they worry that the stigma of having an incarcerated parent will make things worse.

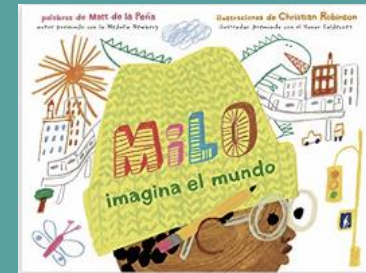
