I, my Minister of  
the Gospel, or my Office legally au-  
thorized to administer the rite of Matrimony;

Whereas, Applications having been made  
to the County Judge of Hillsborough County  
of the State of Florida, for a license for  
marriage, and it appearing to the sat-  
isfaction of the said County Judge that  
no legal impediments exist to the  
marriage now sought to be celebrated  
that we therefore do authorize you to  
unite in the Holy Rite of Matrimony

George Hayne and Sarah Campbell  
and that you make return of the  
same, duly certified under your hand  
to the County Judge aforesaid.

Witness, O. C. Harrison, County Judge,  
and the seal of said Court at the  
Court House in Tampa this 14th  
day of June A.D. 1894.
