the Gospel or any Officer legally authorized  
to solemnize the Rite of Matrimony:

Whereas, Application having been made  
to the County Judge of Hathornough County  
of the State of Maine, for a license for  
marriage, and to appearing to the satis-  
faction of said County Judge that  
no legal impediments exist to the  
marriage now sought to be solemn-  
ized, there are therefore to authorize  
you to unite in the Holy Estate of  
Matrimony, Edmund Hays

and  
Georgia Saunders

and that you make return of the same  
only certified under your hand, to  
the County Judge aforesaid.
