STATE OF FLORIDA, County of Hillsborough
To any Minister of the Gospel, or any Officer legally authorized to solemnize the Rite of Matrimony:  Whereas, Application having been made to the County Judge of Hillsborough County, of the State of Florida, for a license for Marriage, and it appearing to the satisfaction of said County Judge that no legal impediment exists to the Marriage now sought to be solemnized, these are therefore to authorize you to unite in the HOLY ESTATE OF MATRIMONY,

and that you make return of the same, duly certified under your hand, to the County Judge aforesaid.  Why was C. F. HARRISON, County Judge, and the seal of said.
