Hillborough County To any Minister
of the Gospel or any Officer legally
authorized to solemnize the Rite of
Matrimony:

Whereas Application having been
made to the County Judge of Hill-
borough County, of the State of Florida,
for a license for Marriage; and it ap-
pearing to the satisfaction of said

County Judge that no legal imped-
iments exist to the Marriage now
sought to be solemnized, there are
therefore to authorize you to unite in
the Holy Estate of Matrimony

William H. Kyle

and

Mary Johnson

and that you make return of the
same, duly certified, under your
hand, to the County Judge aforesaid.

House in Tampa, this 2nd day of
May A.D. 1842
