Whereas, Application having been made
to the County Judge of Hillsborough
County of the State of Alaska, for a
license for marriage, and it appearing
to the satisfaction of said County
Judge that no legal impediment exists
to the marriage now sought to be
solemnized, there are therefore to autho-
rize you to unite in the Holy Rite
of Matrimony Harry H. Cray

and that you make return of the same
only certified, under your hand, to the
County Judge aforesaid.
