

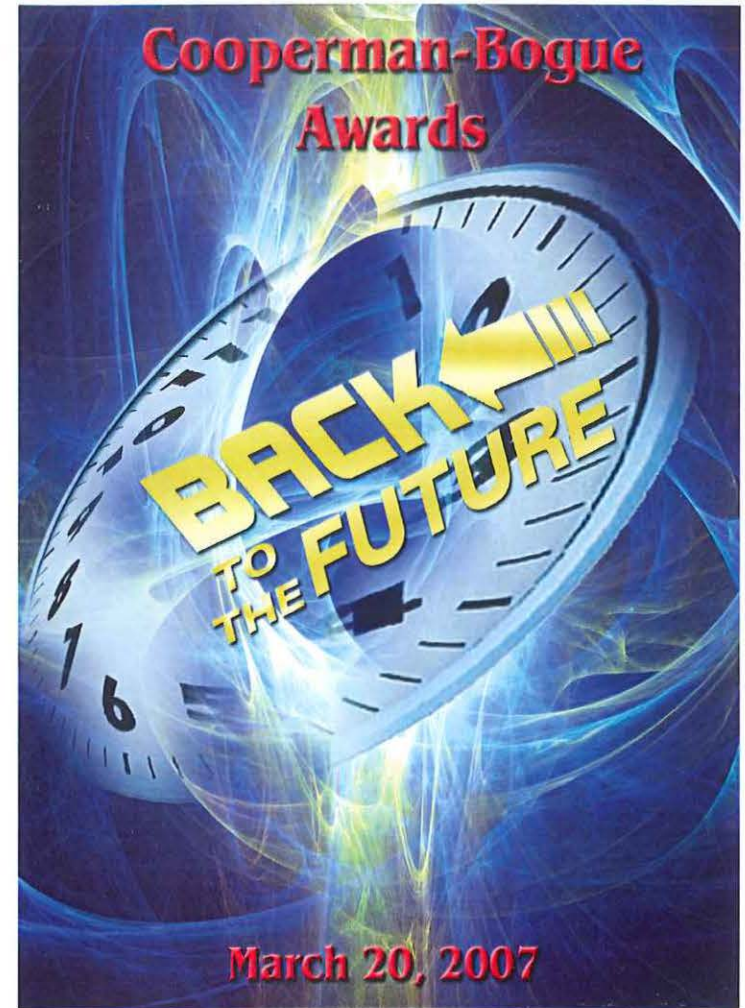
Thirteenth Annual Cooperman-Bogue Awards
