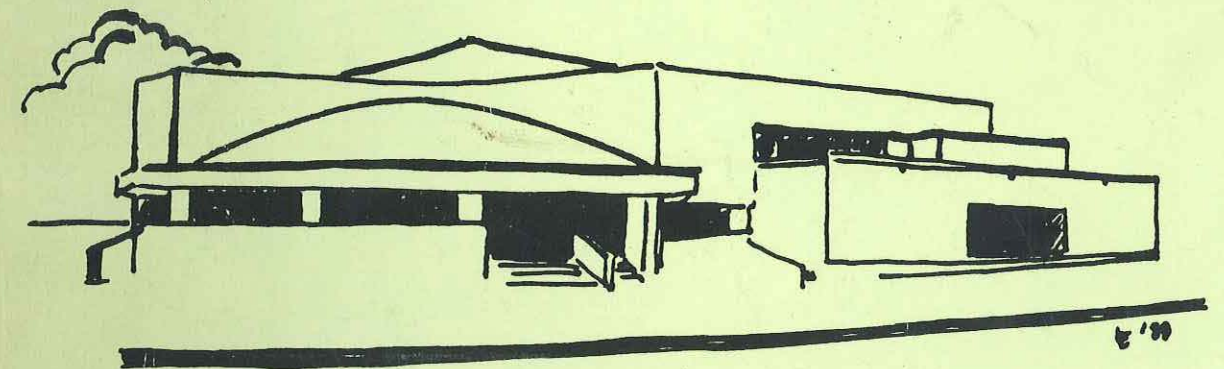

- 1. Press line button of call

TRANSFER

- 1. Press TRANSFER
- 2. Dial extension #
- 3. Announce caller
- 4. Hang up

RECONNECT

- 1. Press CONNECT.

CONFERENCE CALL

Allows up to eight parties in a conversation.
Call the first person, then

- 1. Press FLASH
- 2. Dial next EXTENSION or OUTSIDE NUMBER
- 3. Press CONF (or FLASH *4) to connect each party

To RECONNECT with conference if call
is refused, busy, or isn't answered

- 1. Press CONNECT

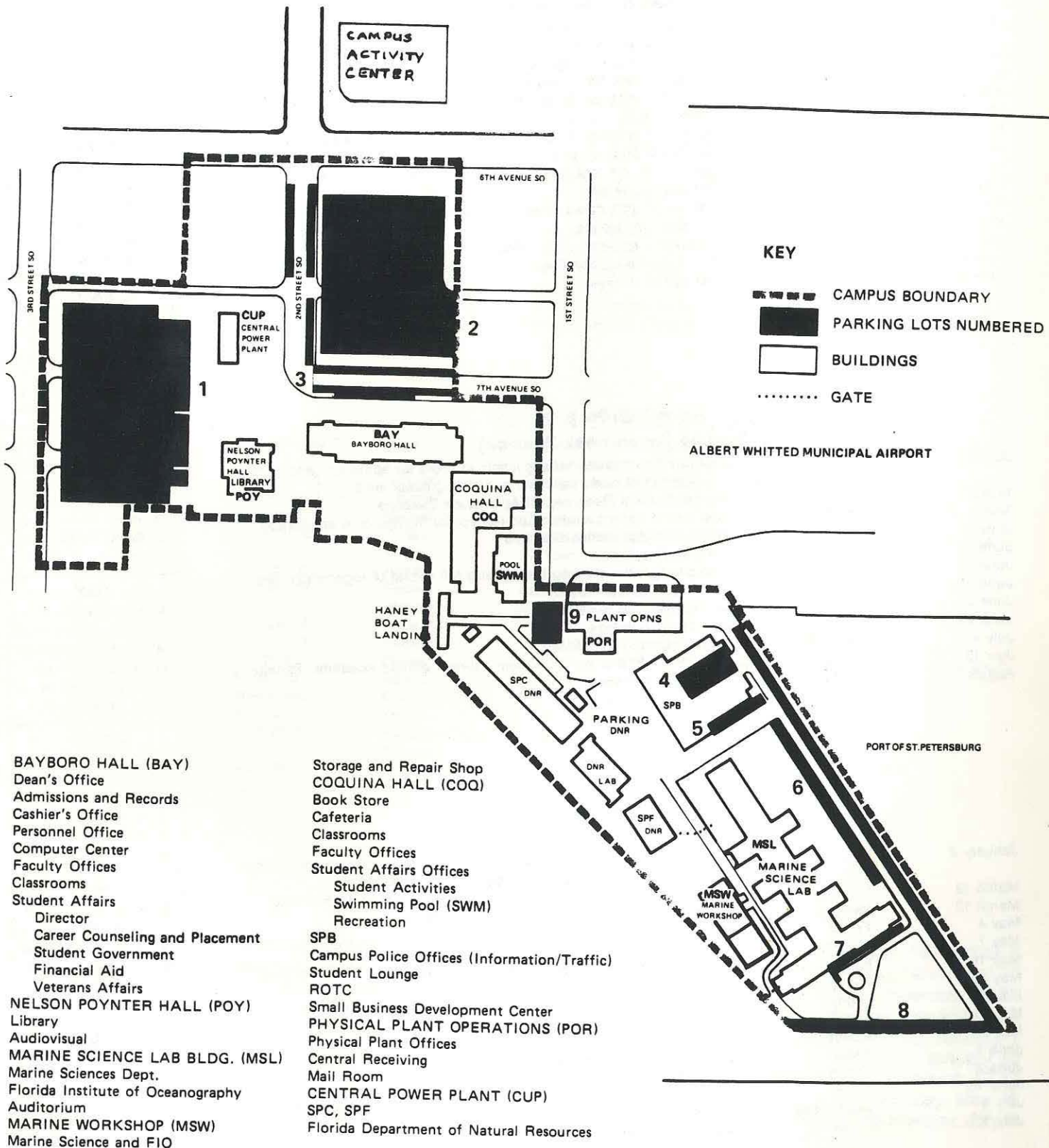
