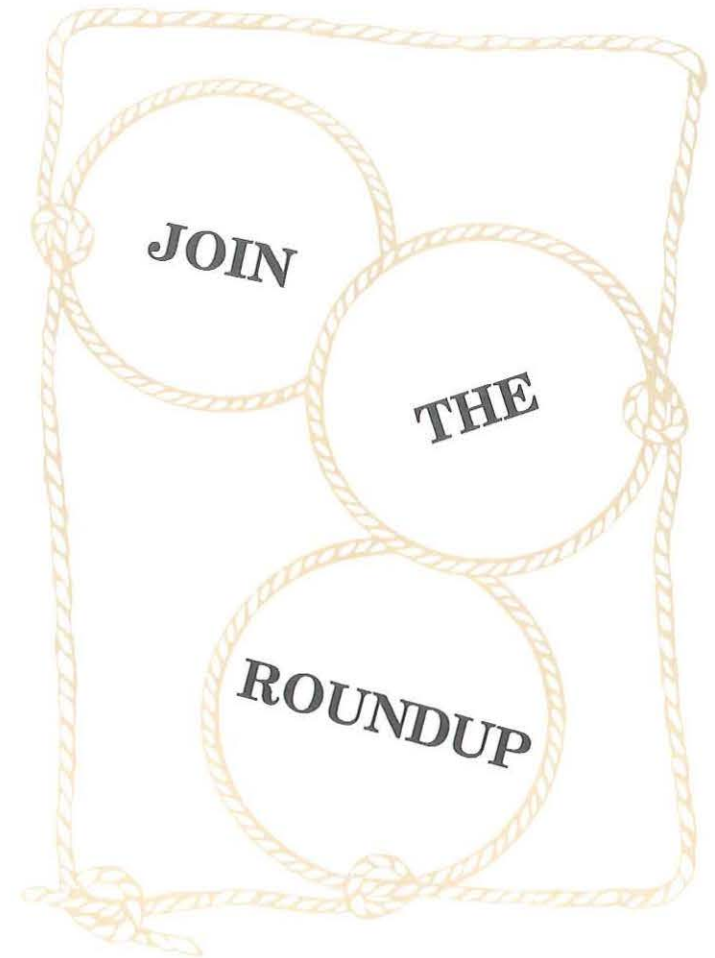


Fourth Annual Cooperman-Bogue Awards

Long after regular work hours, at a kitchen table not an office desk, the late Lincoln Bogue and Leonard Cooperman drafted legislation in 1945 that forever changed the quality of life for Pinellas County's children and families. The legislation set into motion the unique taxing authority known as the Juvenile Welfare Board. In honor of these two men, who went far beyond the confines of the ordinary work day and a routine schedule to improve the quality of life for others, the Juvenile Welfare Board sponsors the Cooperman-Bogue Awards. Honorees are those who consistently provide 110% of effort in their jobs... who consistently perform above and beyond the job description and requirements to serve the children and families of Pinellas. Above all, the honorees have been judged to exemplify the belief that the human element makes a difference in the lives of others, and that the human touch extends far beyond the confines of a routine work day, in a neat office, in a convenient but uncaring manner. Each year, four quarterly winners are selected, from which the annual winner is chosen.
