General Information

- The official nomination form or a duplicate of the form must be used.
- Additional materials will not be accepted or used in support of the nomination.
- Nominations should be typed or clearly printed.
- Entries will not be returned.
- Eligible nominations will be based on the significance of the contribution to an agency, not on a minimum dollar or in-kind equivalent value.
- Businesses may be nominated for significant contributions made during the time period of 1/1/06 to 12/15/06.

The selection committee will be comprised of a representative from each of JWB's three Community Councils, and two Juvenile Welfare Board members.

The selection committee will review nominations and select a maximum of two Corporate Recognition Awards, with recipient(s) being notified by February 16, 2007.
