Issue: Undergraduate Catalog of the University of South Florida St. Petersburg

Information: Authorize amended Regulation USF 1.005 and revised 2011-2012 USF St. Petersburg Undergraduate Catalog.

Background information:

The Florida Board of Governors Resolution (1/7/03) provides that each board of trustees may adopt regulations to implement the provisions of law conferring duties upon it. Such regulations must be adopted pursuant to the Board of Governors Regulation Development Procedure (7/21/05) and must be consistent with law and the resolutions and strategic plan of the Board of Governors. The BOG Procedure also calls for a university to monitor the effects of new regulations and periodically review existing regulations to ensure they are current and consistent.

Amendments are proposed to the *USF St. Petersburg Undergraduate Catalog*. The Catalog includes information on admissions, degree requirements, curricula offerings, and facilities.

Major amendments to the Undergraduate Catalog for USF St. Petersburg are the addition of two new degree programs, the B.S. in Health Sciences and the B.S. in Entrepreneurship. The 2011-2012 proposed amendments to the *USF St. Petersburg Undergraduate Catalog* have been reviewed and approved by the respective programs and colleges; the USF St. Petersburg Undergraduate Council, and the Regional Vice Chancellor for Academic Affairs. Following is a summary of the major proposed revisions to the *USF St. Petersburg Undergraduate Catalog*.
